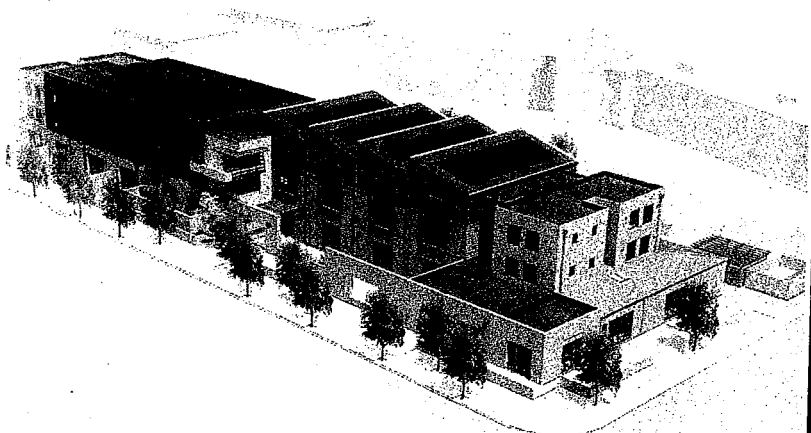

You may qualify if head of household is age 62 years or older and you meet the following maximum annual income and asset limits:

- 1 person \$36,950 • 2 persons \$42,200 • 3 persons \$47,500
- Family's total net asset not exceeding \$100,000
- Family does not have an ownership interest in a suitable home in which the family has a legal right to reside unless the family is making a good faith effort to sell the home and the subsequent proceeds are within the net asset limit.

*Rents and income guidelines are subject to change per regulatory recertification. Other restrictions apply.

Reasonable accommodations will be made for persons needing to receive the applications in another manner upon request.
