- 1. Monthly or Annual Income** - Bring pay stubs *or* last tax return if you can
- 2. Social Security Number** - Bring Naturalization Certificate if you are a recent citizen or don't have a Social Security number yet
- 3. Birthdate**
- 4. Address** - bring a recent utility bill (PG&E *or* telephone *or* cable) if you can

OR
You may not be able to get coverage in 2014 & you may have to pay a tax penalty**
